VOTER REGISTRATION CHANGES

You may register to vote, update your signature or change your voter registration information at the Elections Office, the Tax Collector's Office, or the Flagler County Public Library. Florida Voter Registration Applications may be picked up at Driver's License Offices and all public libraries, city halls and post offices. You may also download an application online from the Elections Office website: FlaglerElections.gov

REGISTRATION BOOKS CLOSING

The deadline for citizens who are not registered to vote or who wish to change their party affiliation is July 22, 2024.

FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE



If you wish to vote for a partisan candidate in a Primary Election you must be a registered voter in the party for which the Primary is being held. Party change deadline for the upcoming Primary Election is July 22, 2024. Remember to vote!

Please note that regardless of party affiliation, all voters are eligible to vote for Non-Partisan races on the ballot during this election. City of Palm Coast voters will be able to cast a ballot for the city races. Non-partisan and city races could be decided on the Primary ballots.

CANVASSING BOARD

The Flagler County Canvassing Board will convene at the office of the Flagler County Supervisor of Elections, 1769 E. Moody Blvd., Bldg. 2, Ste. 101, Bunnell, Florida for the testing of ballot tabulating equipment and canvassing of ballots. In accordance with the Sunshine Law, these meetings will be open to the public. Reasonable access will be granted to authorized persons to review ballot materials pursuant to Section 101.572 (2), Florida Statutes.

VOTE BY MAIL INFORMATION

As of December 31, 2022 all Vote-By-Mail requests on file expired. If you previously had a request on file, you may need to update your request for 2024. Any registered and qualified voter in Flagler County may choose to vote by mail. You may request a mail ballot in person, by mail, fax, online or by telephone. To request your ballot mailed to an address not on file provide your name, address, date of birth, either FL Driver License or last 4 of Social Security Number, address to which ballot is to be mailed and signature on a Vote-By-Mail request. Mail ballot request deadline is **AUGUST 8, 2024**.

Any registered and qualified voter in Flagler County may vote early at one of four early voting sites in the county according to this schedule:

VOTER SIGNATURE UPDATES

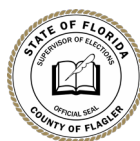
