VOTER REGISTRATION CHANGES

You may register to vote, update your signature or change your voter registration information at the Elections Office, the Tax Collector's Office, or the Flagler County Public Library. Florida Voter Registration Applications may be picked up at Driver License Offices, Public Libraries, City Halls, and Post Offices. You may also download an application online from the Elections Office website: FlaglerElections.gov

REGISTRATION BOOKS CLOSING

The deadline for citizens who are not registered to vote or who wish to change their party affiliation is July 22, 2024.

If you wish to vote for a partisan candidate in a Primary Election you must be a registered voter in the party for which the Primary is being held. Party change deadline for the upcoming Primary Election is July 22, 2024. Remember to vote!

Please note that regardless of party affiliation, all voters are eligible to vote for non-partisan races on the ballot during this election. All City of Palm Coast voters will be able to cast a ballot for their city races. Primary Elections are important! Some non-partisan and city races could be decided in the Primary.

ELECTION READY CHECKLIST

REGISTER TO VOTE:

Have you recently moved to Flagler County? Florida residents can use Online Voter Registration to register to vote or update their registration. You may also register to vote or update your registration by mail or in person. The registration deadline for new voters and party changes is **July 22, 2024** for the Primary Election. UPDATE YOUR ADDRESS:

If you have moved since the last election, you need to update your address before you vote. Call (386) 313-4170 or change your address online: FlaglerElections.gov/vote

MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE:

There are three ways to vote in Florida. Voters can choose to vote by mail, vote early, or vote on Election Day. If you choose to vote on Election Day, you must vote in your assigned precinct location. Find your precinct here:

VOTE BY MAIL INFORMATION

All mail ballot requests expired after the 2022 election cycle. If you previously had a request on file, you may need to update and renew your request for 2024. Any registered and qualified voter in Flagler County may choose to vote by mail. You may request a mail ballot in person, by mail, fax, online or by telephone. To request your ballot mailed to an address not on file, you must provide your name, address, date of birth, either FL Driver License or last 4 of Social Security number, address to which ballot is to be mailed and signature on a Vote-By-Mail request. The deadline to request a mail ballot: **AUGUST 8, 2024.**

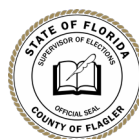
VOTER SIGNATURE UPDATES

Signatures on Vote-By-Mail ballots are compared to the voter's signature on file. Signatures must be updated using the Voter Registration Application, which may be picked up at Driver License Offices, Public Libraries, City Halls, and Post Offices. You may also download an application online from the Elections Office website: FlaglerElections.gov
